Commissioner Simpson to announce Airport Improvement Grants with national aviation organizations

AOPA to hold Town Hall Meeting with local pilots

(Trenton) - New Jersey Department of Transportation Commissioner James Simpson will announce grants to help public use airports advance safety and other projects. He will be joined by Aircraft Owner and Pilots Association (AOPA) President Craig Fuller, General Aviation Manufacturers Association (GAMA) President Pete Bunce, and New Jersey Economic Development Authority CEO Michele Brown who will speak about the vital role general aviation airports provide to support economic development.
