## AERONAUTICAL STUDY 12-ANE-209-NR

**PROPOSAL:** To decommission BRIDGEPORT VOR/DME/RCO, Bridgeport, CT. BDR VOR with DME/RCO serves 14 airports. The DME and RCO services of this VOR will be evaluated and retained, if necessary.

The BDR VOR/DME is identified as a candidate for decommissioning by the Eastern Service Area because of the need for required infrastructure upgrades. Water damage and electrical issues, along with cracks in the foundation and the shelter shifting on the foundation would require an estimated \$8.3 million to bring this facility back up to standards. Policy now requires that decommissioning must be evaluated for all VOR facilities prior to upgrading or performing major repairs.
