Thank you for the RSVP to camp at the AOPA Fly-In at Beaufort, North Carolina! We are excited to have you with us. *We encourage an early arrival on Friday to ensure your space.* Camping will be available Friday and Saturday nights.

Camping Area

Aircraft for camping will be located in the three grassy areas along taxiway A as shown below by the yellow boxes and lines. Upon landing, follow the ground frequency published in the fly-in NOTAM. Place the attached "C" on aircraft glare shield for marshaling to the designated camping area.



Campsite Rules and Responsibilities

- Only one tent per plane unless a second tent is needed for immediate family members. All tents must fit within the footprint of the aircraft.
- Please use caution when starting engines to be certain pedestrians and other campers are safely away from the aircraft.
- Alcoholic beverage consumption is prohibited in the camping area.
- Smoking is prohibited in the camping area.
- Pets are permitted in the camping area, provided they are on a leash at ALL times and droppings are cleaned up.
- Coolers must remain secured at your campsite location.
- This is "primitive camping," so please be prepared for your personal comfort.

Fire Safety

Beaufort-Morehead Airport Authority strictly prohibits wood campfires and charcoal grills anywhere on airport property and in the aircraft camping areas.
