Dear ASN Volunteer,

I wanted to take a moment to introduce myself and bring you up to speed on some exciting things that are happening with the AOPA advocacy team.

My name is Jim Coon, and I am AOPA's Senior Vice President of Government Affairs—the AOPA department responsible for our advocacy efforts, including the Airport Support Network program.

I want you to know how important you are to AOPA's efforts to protect our freedom to fly. Your efforts at your home airport and with pilots in your area help build strong community relationships, prevent small problems from becoming big ones, and keep us informed about the issues that affect your flying. I consider ASN volunteers to be the lynchpin in our efforts to protect our nation's general aviation airports, and I want you to know that all of us at AOPA are committed to supporting you and to the ASN program.

In recent months, we've been making a number of changes in our government affairs department, and some of these have affected the ASN program.
