Summary: Relates to gasoline and diesel fuel taxes; provides for an additional gasoline and diesel fuel taxes; provides for an adjustment of the additional gasoline and diesel fuel tax rate at certain times if certain criteria are met; provides for the additional gasoline and diesel fuel taxes to be based upon the difference between the Border States Average Gasoline Tax and the Alabama Tax on Gasoline; prohibits the enactment of local taxes on gasoline or diesel fuel except under certain conditions.
