Summary: Decouples from changes to the federal estate tax since 2003; provides for a reduction and phase-out of the pension exclusion, disallow the domestic production activities deduction, establishes a cap for itemized deductions, defines taxpayer, provides for changes to income tax rates, provides for a refundable earned income credit, recognizes changes in income tax credits, lowers the exclusion threshold, and changes apportionment methods to use a throwback rule and market-based sourcing for receipts.

Summary: Adds to the definition of local government and additional definitions; clarifies the violations that may be enforced by a code enforcement board; clarifies procedures for when a vacancy is not filled; requires regular meetings to be set by ordinance for the code enforcement board and permit special or emergency meetings; allows code enforcement boards to appoint hearing officers when authorized by local ordinance and set duties and authorities.

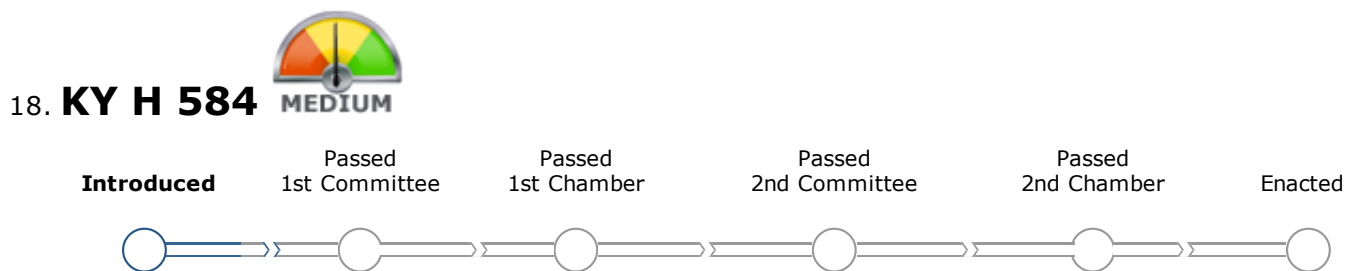

Summary: Extends the new motor vehicle tire fee; allows a specified administrative fee to be paid to the Infrastructure Authority for the administration of projects; increases the executive agency lobbyist registration fee; allows the Auditor of Public Accounts to charge for any additional expenses incurred; requires each agency of the Executive Branch to pay an amount required for the operation of the Personnel Board.

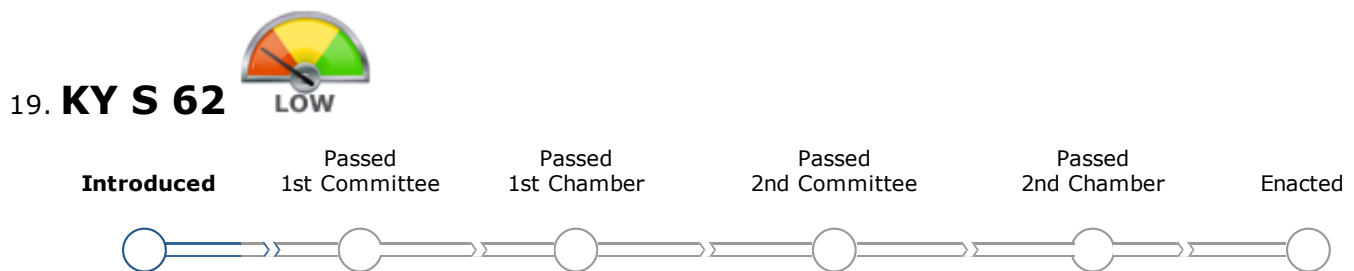

Summary: Creates a new section of KRS Chapter 438 to define critical infrastructure, unmanned aircraft, and unmanned aircraft system, and to clarify what is not included in the term unmanned aircraft system; creates a new section of KRS Chapter 438 to prohibit the use of an unmanned aircraft system to collect evidence or information about critical infrastructure without prior written consent and make the unlawful use of an unmanned aircraft system for this purpose a Class A or Class B misdemeanor.

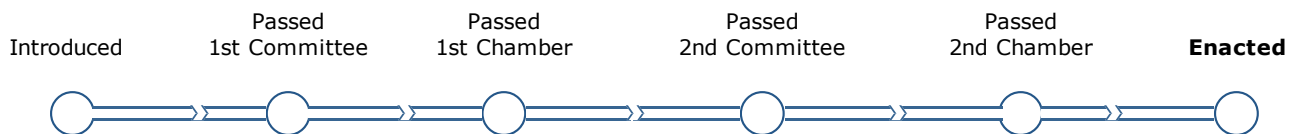

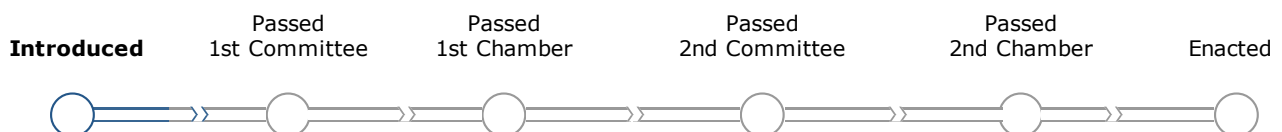

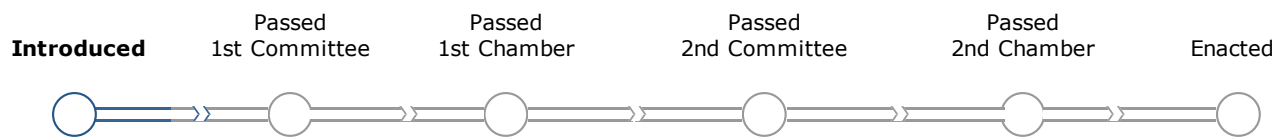
