Dear Colonel Taylor:

This letter is to inform you that we have granted your petition to extend and amend Exemption No. 7960, as amended. It explains the basis for our decision and describes its effect.

The Basis for Our Decision

On June 21, 2006, you petitioned the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) on behalf of the United States Air Force (USAF) for an extension of and amendment to Exemption No. 7960, as amended. That exemption from § 91.209(a)(1) and (b) of Title 14, Code of Federal Regulations allows the USAF to conduct night-vision-goggle (NVG) lights-out training in certain military operations areas. The amendment you request would add the Dolphin military operating area (MOA), which was not operational at the time of the original exemption request.

In your petition, you indicate that there has been no change in the conditions and reasons relative to public interest and safety that were the basis for granting the original exemption.

The FAA has determined that good cause exists for not publishing a summary of the petition in the <u>Federal Register</u> because the requested extension of and amendment to the exemption would not set a precedent, and any delay in acting on this petition would be detrimental to the USAF.

Our Decision

The FAA has determined that the justification for the issuance of Exemption No. 7960, as amended, remains valid with respect to this exemption and is in the public interest. Therefore, under the authority provided by 49 U.S.C. 40113 and 44701, which the FAA Administrator has delegated to me, I grant your petition.

The Effect of Our Decision

Our decision extends the termination date of Exemption No. 7960, as amended, to January 31, 2009, unless sooner superseded or rescinded. This exemption will also add the Dolphin MOA to the list of approved MOAs for operations conducted under this exemption.

All conditions and limitations of Exemption No. 7960, as amended, remain the same. This letter must be attached to, and is a part of, Exemption No. 7960.
