



Aircraft Display – 2008 Show Facts At-A-Glance

Please make sure all of your demo pilots have a copy of this information.

Arrival

To assure maximum exposure of your display aircraft to customers, please plan to arrive by 7:00 pm on Friday, June 6. AOPA staff will be on hand to position your aircraft in the display area. In the event that you cannot arrive by Friday night, please contact Craig Brown at 301-695-2117 as soon as possible to determine if special arrangements can be made. After landing your aircraft, please taxi toward the ramp in front of the AOPA building. Contact AOPA advisory on 122.85 for further instructions.

Registration

You may pick up your registration badges and on-site information at the exhibitor registration desk located inside the main exhibit tent behind the AOPA building. Registration is open on Friday from 3:00 pm to 8:00 pm and on Saturday from 7:00 am to 8:15 am.

Exhibit Hours

Exhibit hours are 8:30 am to 5:00 pm on Saturday, June 7. For the integrity of the display and for maximum exposure, your aircraft must remain in place and be staffed during exhibit hours. Departures prior to 5 pm are prohibited.

Lunch

A lunch menu is included in this kit for your convenience. If you would like a box lunch delivered to you at Fly-In, please fill out this form and fax it back. You will need exact change on-site to pay for your lunch (\$7.00). Please do not send payment to AOPA in advance because it will be collected on-site.

Washing & Cleaning of Your Aircraft

Arrangements for aircraft to be washed or cleaned should be made through Frederick Aviation at 301-662-8156 in advance of your arrival. Aircraft may not be washed once they are placed in the display.
