PROPOSED DECOMMISSIONING Runway 01 LOC/DME Bettles, AK

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is conducting an aeronautical study of a proposal to decommission the Bettles, AK, Runway 01 Localizer/Distance Measuring Equipment (LOC/DME).

The FAA proposes to decommission and remove the LOC/DME and associated hardware infrastructure in order to defray the cost of replacement. Ancillary to decommissioning and removal of the LOC/DME, the Bettles Airport LOC/DME approach would be cancelled. There will be no reclassification of existing airspace and the current Federal Airways will not be affected. The intent of this notice is to inform the flying public of the proposal to decommission and remove the BTT LOC/DME and provide an opportunity to comment.

DATES: Comments must be received on or before April 3, 2013.
