

# 2015 AOPA AV8RS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

# **Background**

AOPA AV8RS is an AOPA membership category available at no charge to teens, ages 13-18, interested in aviation. The youth membership allows AOPA to make an early connection with young people and raises awareness of aviation and flight through education, engagement, and support. AOPA AV8RS is funded through the AOPA Foundation and made possible through the Emil Buehler Perpetual Trust. Only teen members currently enrolled in the AOPA AV8RS membership category are eligible to participate in the AOPA AV8RS scholarship program which will award up to \$15,000 in financial assistance. #### **AOPA AV8RS Scholarship Program**

In an effort to support outstanding AOPA AV8R teen members, we will be awarding up to \$15,000 in financial assistance this fall to teens currently enrolled in the free **AOPA AV8RS youth membership category** (<a href="www.aopa.org/av8rs">www.aopa.org/av8rs</a>). The recipients will be chosen based on merit, previous accomplishments, ability to set goals, and demonstrated commitment to general aviation

The AOPA AV8RS Scholarship Program supports outstanding AOPA AV8R teen members in accomplishing their educational and career goals. The recipients will be chosen based on merit, previous accomplishments, ability to set goals, and demonstrated commitment to general aviation. It is open to all **current members of AOPA AV8RS** pursuing an aviation-related goal, including:

- 1. Primary pilot's certificate (have not completed the FAA practical test/checkride at time of application)
- 2. Study in an aviation/aerospace field through an accredited aviation program at a college/university, technical school or aviation academy
- 3. Aviation or aerospace camp

#### **Deadline / Award Date**

A completed application and supporting documentation must be received on or before **August 31, 2015** via mail or email. Applications received after the designated deadline date will not be considered. <u>No exceptions</u>.

Scholarship winners will be notified by **October 31, 2015**. Those who have not been selected will not be notified. For a list of scholarship winners, please visit <a href="https://www.aopa.org/av8rs">www.aopa.org/av8rs</a> after **November 9, 2015**.

Please note: If you are not eligible to participate but are a current paid AOPA member, we encourage you to submit a scholarship application to the AOPA Flight Training Scholarship Program which awards more than \$50,000 in financial assistance. Applications for this program are now being accepted through August 9, 2015. ### **General Criteria and Eligibility Requirements**

#### Scholarship applicants must meet all the criteria listed below.

- 1. **Be a current AOPA AV8R member** from the date of the scholarship application through the date it is awarded. Other AOPA membership categories DO NOT QUALIFY for the AOPA AV8RS Scholarship program.
- 2. Be a U.S. citizen or U.S. permanent resident
- 3. Parent or guardian approval if under 18 years of age
- 4. Students must be in good standing at their respective high school, college, university or technical school.
- 5. If applying for flight training assistance:
  - a. Be a current student pilot working toward an initial sport, recreation or private pilot certificate
  - b. Not have completed the FAA practical test/checkride at the time of application
- 6. If applying for assistance towards a field of study in aviation or aerospace
  - a. Has been accepted or currently enrolled in an aviation/aerospace program at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university or vocational technical school.
- 7. If applying to attend an aviation/aerospace camp:
  - a. Recommended by an educator (school administrator, teacher or guidance counselor) to attend a formal aviation or aerospace camp that incorporates a STEM-related curriculum.
- 8. All scholarship awards will be paid directly to the approved flight school, college, technical school, aviation academy/high school, or aviation camp.
- 9. Employees of AOPA and their immediate family members and household members are not eligible to participate in the AOPA AV8RS scholarship program. The term "immediate family members" includes spouses, siblings, children, and grandchildren.

# **Obligations and Responsibilities**

- The applicant's description of his/her personal record should show that s/he can successfully complete the aviation career educational program for which s/he is requesting the scholarship.
- Should the scholarship recipient not fulfill his/her obligation for which the scholarship was intended, the parent or legal guardian of the recipient (or the recipient, if 18 years of age), will be required to return all or any unused portion of the scholarship to the AOPA Foundation.
- Unused flight training funds remaining after 12 months of the award shall be returned to AOPA.

# Right of Refusal, Reassignment, and/or Retraction

The AOPA Foundation, the Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association and/or the scholarship committee has the right to refuse, reassign, and/or retract any scholarship application or award during the judging, awarding or post-awarding process. Refusal/retraction can be based on, but not limited to: false misleading and/or incorrect information provided in the application, statements made during the interview that contradicts application and/or failure to meet any criteria or eligibility requirements.

#### **Application Submittal Process**

<u>APPLICATION DEADLINE</u>: **August 31, 2015**. Application materials must be received **by 5:00 p.m. EST** on this date in order to be considered.

**REQUIRED MATERIALS**: The applicant is responsible for submitting all materials on time. <u>Incomplete applications will</u> not be reviewed.

- Complete this application (attach additional sheets as requested or as necessary). Your name and address should be on all attachments. A typed application is preferred, but not mandatory (except where noted). Must be clearly legible if handwritten.
- 2. A typed essay (no more than two pages double spaced) addressing one of the following topics:
  - a. What is the impact of general aviation on the United States?
  - b. Describe an accomplishment you have been recognized for and its influence on you
  - c. Who has been the most influential on your life and why?
  - d. How did your interest in aviation originate?

While the essay will be judged on content, please make your best effort with grammar and spelling.

- 3. One letter of reference or recommendation from a teacher, counselor, coach, or other adult who is not a relative.
- 4. If applying for assistance towards:
  - a. A field of study at an accredited 2- or 4-year or college, university or vocational technical school, provide a letter of acceptance or most recent transcript, if currently enrolled.
  - b. Flight training at an approved flight school or training program, provide a written report (dated and signed) from the flight school detailing your progress to date and confirming that you have not completed the FAA practical test/checkride.
  - c. An aviation or aerospace camp, provide a name and dates of camp, location, cost, web address, and contact information.

# **Selection Process**

- 1. It is the applicant's responsibility to submit a complete and signed application and all the supporting documentation in one package, which must be received on or before the deadline date as set forth below. The Scholarship Committee accepts no responsibility for incomplete applications, applications not in proper form, lost applications, or any other submission in exception to the above instructions.
- 2. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final and not subject to a review process.
- 3. Scholarship selections shall be made without regard to race, color, national origin, gender, sexual preference, or disability.
- 4. The scholarship awards will be based on the Committee's scores of the overall quality of the application and the scholarship essay. The higher the average score, the higher the probability of selection.
