✓ CHECKLIST FOR STARTING A FLYING CLUB (V3.3)

□ First Steps

- □ Visit the flying club resource library
- □ Contact the AOPA Flying Club team
- \Box Learn about best practices
- □ Get Organized
 - \Box Pick the location
 - □ Establish founding members
 - □ Generate interest in your new club
 - □ Write a mission statement
 - \Box Encourage a safety culture
 - □ Identify suitable aircraft types
- \Box Play by the Rules
 - □ Choose Equity vs Non-equity
 - \Box Select a legal structure
 - \Box Consider tax exempt status
- \Box Master the Money
 - \Box Research insurance
 - □ Understand financing or lease costs
 - □ Estimate maintenance expenses
 - \Box Research hangar or tie-down fees
 - □ Establish your club's income stream

- \Box Put it in Writing
 - \Box Prepare the budget
 - \Box Create bylaws and operating rules
 - \Box File for incorporation, EIN, (and possibly) tax exemption
- □ Fill Your Hangar
 - \Box Complete the purchase process
 - \Box Purchase club insurance
 - □ Sign financing or lease agreements
 - \Box Bring the aircraft home
- □ Running your Flying Club
 - \Box Market and attract members
 - \Box Hold meetings to socialize and conduct business.
 - □ Carry out your club's safety program
